

## Class of 2022 Hornets and Parents:

Welcome to the hive! We hope you have heard that exact statement before. We would like to start by introducing ourselves. We (Allison Campbell and Christen Lindstrom) are your Class Sponsors for the next four years. If there is anything you need you can find Ms. Campbell in room 417 and Mrs. Lindstrom in room 222. Ms. Campbell is a Booker T. Graduate from the class of 2009. Mrs. Lindstrom taught in Tulsa since 2006 and became a hornet teacher in 2015. Both of us are here through hard work and perseverance – skills you will need throughout life. We can't wait to see the mark you make on Booker T Washington HS and the mark it makes on you! This is a very special place to live, learn, and grow and we are happy you are joining the Booker T. family.

We can't wait to meet you at freshman orientation! Please come ready to pay class dues. Class dues are \$30 a year and are due at the beginning of each school year. If they are not paid by the end of each fall semester, then they double to \$60 in the spring. That value will carry over each year if it is not paid. You can pay all of it up front at freshman orientation. If you pay at orientation it is only \$100 for all four years (you'll save \$20). Please note that if you are paying at orientation we can only accept cash (no checks or cards). Dues help pay for homecoming decorations, class activities, and down the road prom and senior activities. If you are not able to pay at freshman orientation, you can come to Mrs. Lindstrom's room (222) and pay (in cash). We will set up an online payment that you can access through the class website. There you can pay by card. It is not currently set up, but should be by the beginning of the school year.

There is an important thing for you to start thinking about before we meet you at freshman orientation. If you are interested in running for class board, you will sign up at the freshman table during orientation. Elections will be the first week of school. Below are the different positions:

1. President
2. Vice President
3. Secretary
4. Treasurer
5. Historian

In order to run you must commit to a keeping a GPA of 2.5 or higher. You are expected to be at all class board meetings (these can be before/after school or during activity period), planned meeting times before/after school to make pep rally banners, and all the class events during homecoming week. Attached is the descriptions of the different positions.

The top 5 things you need to know about the class of 2022 and being a hornet are:

1. Be yourself.
2. Manage your time.
3. Get involved. (class board = see attached)
4. Class Dues are due by the end of the semester if you don't want to pay more.
5. Enjoy it! Four years goes by way too fast!

At freshman orientation there will be t-shirt order forms for the class of 2022 shirt. Payment for the shirt will be due when you fill out an order form. We will not order any extra shirts for you to buy later in the year. Please note, we can only accept cash. If you are unable to order a shirt at orientation, you can fill out an order form and pay in Ms. Campbell's room (417). Orders are due by the end of August. Shirts will most likely be between \$15 - \$25 (depending on if it is a t-

shirt/long sleeve shirt) but we won't know for sure until we get the quote from the printing company.

Lastly, each student is required to complete at least fifteen (15) community service hours their freshman and sophomore year to complete the MYP program. The service hours can be completely through church, local organizations, or clubs at BTW such as Key Club. Attached is the form for service hours. You can also print off the form on the freshman class page or pick one up from the 2022 bulletin board next to Mrs. Lindstrom's room.
